

REFLECTING ON FREEDOM AND RESILIENCE

As we reflect on significant dates like the International Day of Peace and the Independence Day of Armenia on September 21, we are reminded of the universal values of freedom, dignity, and peace. This year, another date, September 27, marks two years since the illegal arrest and detention of Ruben Vardanyan, by Azerbaijani authorities during the massive displacement of Armenians from Artsakh.

For over 30 years, Ruben has dedicated his life to creating in the name of strengthening communities. His work, including UWC Dilijan, the first international boarding school in Armenia, and Aurora Humanitarian Initiative honouring humanitarian heroes, Foundation for Science and Technology, Tatev Revival, Dilijan Development Programme and others, embodies the resilience of an independent Armenia.

The construction of the new church in Dilijan, an initiative he started, has a special meaning in this context. This space will stand as a symbol of faith, resilience, and enduring hope for peace. More than a place of worship, it is designed to be a sanctuary of unity, reflecting the principles Ruben has championed: bringing people together and creating a foundation for future generations.

"It gives Ruben strength that the construction of the church continues despite his imprisonment. On his behalf, I would like to extend my heartfelt gratitude to everyone who has supported him and our family during this difficult time".
