

For decades, Dilijan City Park, once a cherished gathering place, had fallen into neglect. Recognizing its vital role in the life of the town, DDF Foundation took the lead in breathing new life into this public space — restoring its charm, function, and meaning for generations to come.

Nestled along the Aghstev River, the park since 2016 is being transformed into a vibrant, safe, and inclusive environment for all. With thoughtful landscape design and the revitalization of both historic and new pathways, the park once again invites residents and visitors to walk, relax, and connect with nature.

#### FIRST PHASE

OF DILIJAN CITY PARK REVIVAL (2016-2021) The first phase of the Dilijan City Park revival focused on restoring and beautifying its 13-hectare territory, including the lake area, which had been abandoned and underused for over 30 years.

## SECOND PHASE OF DILIJAN CITY PARK REVIVAL (2022-2025)

The **second phase** of the Dilijan City Park revival focused on creating major social and mixed-use spaces.





Renovation of the sports ground (in cooperation with a partner company).



A new children's route at the Verev Rope Park.

Construction of a small amphitheater for cultural and community events.



The immersive museum "Ditaran" – the only 3D experience in Armenia that allows locals and tourists to explore the country's culture and history.





Partial construction of the Rock Café, featuring special climbing equipment.



"Impulse" youth football academy establishment with more than 130 young talents learning to play football

#### **SECOND PHASE**

Further enhancements included new landscaped areas and general infrastructure upgrades, enabling the park to host largescale events with over 10,000 guests and attracting many local and Yerevan-based businesses to operate during these occasions.

Dilijan hosted major events for the first time and boosted tourism for more than 3x times for the season.








